## - Construction Site of Minami-Sunamachi Station (TOKYO METRO)

### Half-Day Visit [Morning (10A) / Afternoon (10B)]

(Friday, November 1, 2019)

#### Course Outline:

The main visit site is Minami-Sunamachi Station, of the Tozai Line of Tokyo Metro. It is one of the busiest stations in Japan. To resolve this congestion and to increase convenience for customers, Tokyo Metro is promoting a large-scale renewal construction project which involves additions of a new platform, and new escalators, elevators and entrances/exits as barrier-free facilities. In this Technical Visit, you can see the construction site and also its construction project information center (Metro Sunachica). You will be provided an overview of this project, and have a chance to learn about underground renewal construction in Japan. This Technical Visit will be offered in a morning course (10A) and an afternoon course (10B).
